Tom Wilson died, aged 22, from an accident whilst hockey training. His mother, Lisa, has recently joined the bell ringing team. The bells will be rung continuously for 2 hours with as many people taking part as possible. The bell ropes will be swapped from person to person in the form of a relay so that the bells are kept ringing for the whole time. Everyone who takes part will make a contribution to the charity.
