



To access the Diocese of Chelmsford online safeguarding training, please follow the guidance below.

- Open the following link in your browser:  
<https://www.chelmsford.anglican.org/safeguarding/training>
- Click on Co Basic Awareness and C1 Foundation
- Scroll to the red highlighted heading **Undertake the Online Safeguarding Training**.
- Choose the Chelmsford Diocese and log in or set up your account if not done so already. Use the **parish code 04.08** for a new account and the enrolment **keyword is snowdrop** (relating to child safeguarding training) or **poppy** (relating to adult safeguarding training)
- Once you are logged in choose the E-learning Child Safeguarding 2019 course.

Hopefully you should now be in the right place to do the training!

When you have completed the module you will be emailed a certificate.
